FROM: Interstate 287

Traveling on Interstate 287, exit at Route 206/Route 202 NORTH. Stay on Route 206 and proceed to Chester. Once in Chester, turn LEFT at the Larison's Turkey Farm traffic light which is West Main Street and also the junction for Route 513. You will be heading WEST to Long Valley. The distance to Long Valley is 4-3/10 miles. When you reach the center of Long Valley, turn RIGHT at the light. You will cross over a stone bridge (South Branch of the Raritan River). This is Schooley's Mountain Rd.

Proceed up Schooley's Mountain Rd. for 8/10 of a mile past the Washington Township Municipal Building. Turn RIGHT onto Camp Washington Road. There is a large sign at the corner which reads MORRIS COUNTY PARK SYSTEM.

The entrance to the Lodge is on Camp Washington Road, approximately 4/10 of a mile on the right. The address is 54 Camp Washington Rd.

FROM: Interstate 78 (you can get on 78 from 287 as an alternate to using 206)

Take Tewksbury exit 24 which puts you on Route 517 and Route 523. Head NORTH to Tewksbury and stay on Rt. 517. Rt. 517 terminates in Long Valley Center and becomes Schooley's Mountain Road. (You will proceed through the traffic light at the Long Valley Center onto Schooley's Mountain Road.)

Continue up Schooley's Mountain Rd. for 8/10 of a mile past the Washington Township Municipal Building. Turn RIGHT onto Camp Washington Road. There is a large sign at the corner which reads MORRIS COUNTY PARK SYSTEM.

The entrance to the Lodge is on Camp Washington Road, approximately 4/10 of a mile on the right. The address is 54 Camp Washington Rd.

FROM: Interstate 80

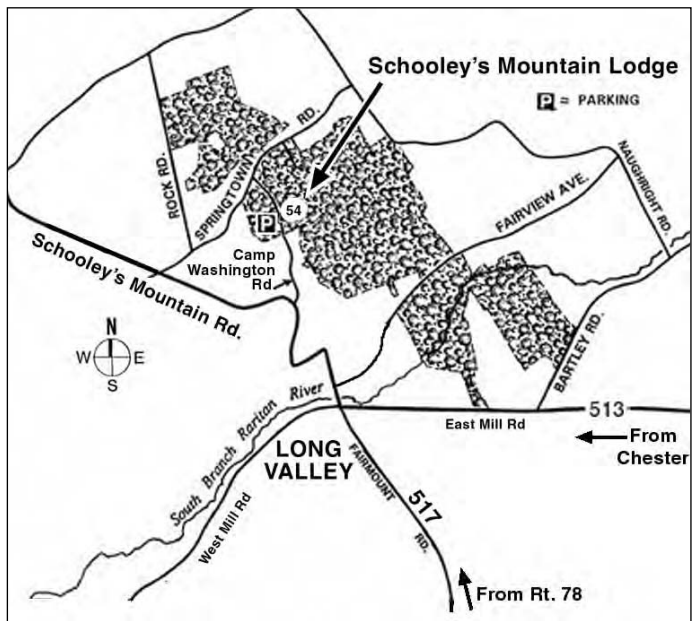
Traveling on Interstate 80, exit at Route 206 SOUTH. Stay on Route 206 and proceed to Chester.

Once in Chester, turn RIGHT at the Larison's Turkey Farm traffic light which is West Main Street and also the junction for Route 513. You will be heading WEST to Long Valley. The distance to Long Valley is 4-3/10 miles.

When you reach the center of Long Valley, turn RIGHT at the light. You will cross over a stone bridge (South Branch of the Raritan River). This is Schooley's Mountain Rd.

Proceed up Schooley's Mountain Rd. for 8/10 of a mile past the Washington Township Municipal Building. Turn RIGHT onto Camp Washington Road. There is a large sign at the corner which reads MORRIS COUNTY PARK SYSTEM.

The entrance to the Lodge is on Camp Washington Road, approximately 4/10 of a mile on the right. The address is 54 Camp Washington Rd.
